Join the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (Chancellor's Office) and the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges (ASCCC) for a collaborative webinar: **Implementing the New Course Outline of Record** on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, from 12:00 p.m.–1:00 p.m.

This webinar will help curriculum committees and faculty translate newly revised Title 5 requirements into clear, practical actions that support student equity and success through course development and review. Grounded in the October 2025 revisions to Title 5 sections 55001 and 55001.5, the session focuses on how these changes strengthen course outlines of record (COR) and local curriculum processes to serve today's diverse learners better. Participants will learn how to integrate Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Accessibility (DEIA) and Universal Design for Learning (UDL) into the COR, gain clarity on updated required elements, and navigate new submission timelines and processes in the Chancellor's Office Curriculum Inventory (COCI). The webinar will also highlight approaches for aligning curriculum committee review practices and faculty workflows with the regulations, advancing more equitable, accessible, and student-centered learning environments.
