### Academic Senate Report 3/28/14

- <u>Presidents Report: AP 7120:</u> Recruitment and Hiring- Mt. SAC needs to be in compliance with the Faculty Obligation Number(FON). This has to do with the growth and replacement position consideration. The Task force is going to be proposing recommendations to the Senate to get back into compliance with (FON).
- <u>During the Professional Development Council update</u>: the President committed to offering two hours of Adjunct Faculty pay at the non-teaching rate for participation in Flex-Day.
- <u>Enrollment Update:</u> new figures were presented that indicated an increase in total credit enrollment for 2013-14. Much of this was due to the addition of sections in winter and spring 2014. The target for growth has been set at 3.5% rather than 3% in the expectation that there will be uncaptured growth funding at other colleges that Mt. SAC can capitalize on.
- <u>International Students Advisory Committee:</u> We currently have 551 international students. Also, discussions for promoting building dorms for International and student-athletes.
- Committee Positions Available for Fall 2014: See Hand out
- <u>Curriculum Report:</u> Elimination of 4 year review due dates. It has been changed from Oct. 31 to May 31.
   This was to coordinate with the same date as the revision and modification curriculum so there is no confusion of having two separate due dates.
- KIN Classes needs to be reviewed: See Hand out
- Courses with arranged hours: All arranged hour classes must be listed on this list.
- <u>Legislative Liaison Report:</u> AB 2558 is a bill that proposes to establish that all contractual faculty must attend Professional Development on top of their contractual professional hours. It has not been passed yet; it's only a proposal.
- <u>Academic Senate Syllabus Task Force:</u> (Action Item) There is going to be a Syllabus Task Force that will give us guidelines for our Syllabi.
