Academic Senate Report

- President's Report: President's Advisory Council (PAC) met on March 26 and discussed and proposed a Task Force on Student Housing. It would be tasked with making a recommendation regarding the proposal to build a 500-bed facility after reviewing a private Feasibility & Needs Analysis and a Supplemental Environmental Impact Report. The facility would be privately operated. The Student HousingTask Force members were assigned and Joe Jennum will be on this task force.
- Campus Wide Committees such as the Student Equity Writing Teams on the Hand outs were approved by
 President Scroggins without senate approval. There is state money for Campus Student Equity Planteams.
 But more discussion on info and input has to be available by November this upcoming Fall semester. If
 anyone is interested on joining one of these teams just contact myself or Liz.
- Curriculum Report: They all have been approved by ED Design. (See handout)
- Resolution 9.02 S14 on Repeatability, this did not pass according to the Changes to Recent Community
