First, the software in voting machines may be faulty. During the 2006 midterm elections, overseers in some states noted that machines switched votes from one candidate to another because of touch-screen problems. Additionally, voting machines can be easily manipulated. In 2004, Maryland hired RABA Technologies to try to hack the state's new voting machines. Computer whizzes were able to vote more than once and change voting outcomes, and they concluded that even high-school students could hack the machines. In Holland, hackers using telephone lines were able to manipulate and delete votes. However, electronic voting has some good points. The elimination of paper ballots is good for the environment. Also, votes can be counted more quickly by machine than they can by hand. Certainly, governments should think twice about implementing electronic voting machines.
