Step Number	Directions
_____	Next, turn right at the light onto Walnut Avenue.
_____	Continue to go down the stairs until you reach the bottom.
_____	Then turn right and enter the doors on your left.
<u>1</u>	The easiest way is to exit Building 30 and go toward Bonita Drive.
_____	When you get to the new buildings on your left, turn left and go down the stairs.
_____	After that, continue straight until you pass the driveway in front of buildings 66 and 67.
_____	Finally, go through the first door on your left to enter the LLC.
