



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Section 3: Tips and Practice for Giving Directions

Tips: Here are some helpful tips on how to give directions to others.

- **1.** Begin with an **introductory phrase**:
  - The easiest way is to . . .

- **2.** Use **short phrases** with the imperative form. Speak slowly and use very careful pronunciation. For example:
  - Go straight.
  - Make a right.
  - Turn left.
- 3. Use transition words or phrases:
  - after that
  - then

  - finally

- **5.** Use **landmarks**. Landmarks are buildings or things on land that are easy to see and recognize. Landmarks tell the person what to look out for. The landmarks are **bold** in the example below:
  - When you see **a large clock**, make a left.
  - At the library, turn right.
  - Turn right on **Temple Ave**. You will see **Mt. SAC** on the corner.
