- Can we fold use of peer-reviewed articles into specialized sessions, such as Biology?
- How do we target those students?
 - o Offer them as online workshops
 - o Offer workshop into the discipline specific classroom (in pilot mode)
 - o Offer face-to-face and online workshops (ultimate goal)

Steps to create specialized workshops include:

- Talking to the faculty to see what they want
- Establishing logistics

How does creation of specialized workshops fit with our overall workshop development plan?

- Work on specialized workshops can be developed in tandem with development of general online workshops.
