	<p>Librarians have concerns with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • authentication from Moodlerooms and LibGuides • challenges with customization <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ We do not know how much customization is needed or available. ◦ Other users report customization has been harder than expected. ◦ Other users report delays to receiving embed codes and keys. • consistency of material • oversimplification of content • no plan for implementing the use of this resource <p>Librarians see benefits in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • providing content to a large population of remote students • addressing cross-campus information literacy needs <p>Decision:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We do not recommend a subscription to Credo Information Literacy Online Course (Yes-2; No-3; Undecided-1).
