Purpose of the Task Force

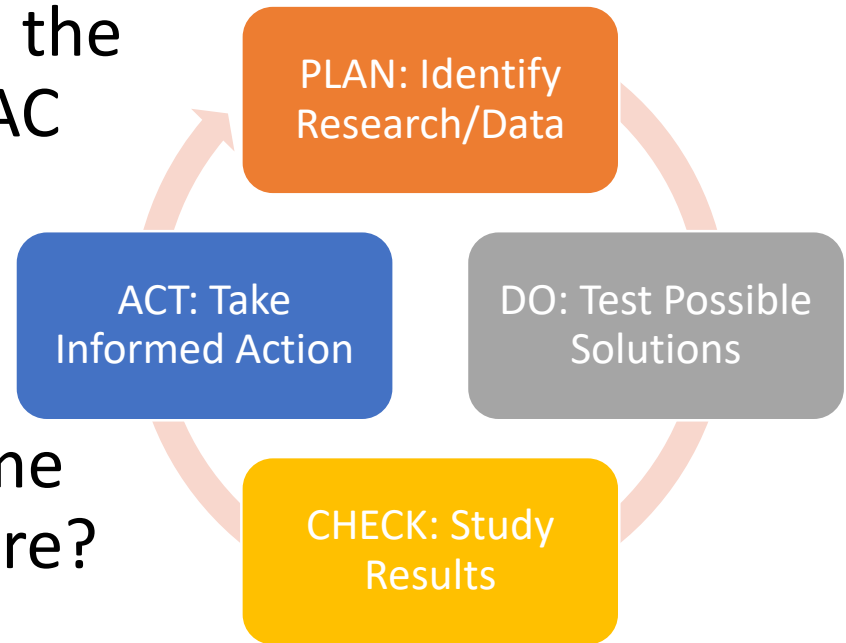


This task force will evaluate the Mt. SAC mascot (Joe Mountie) and athletic moniker (Mounties).

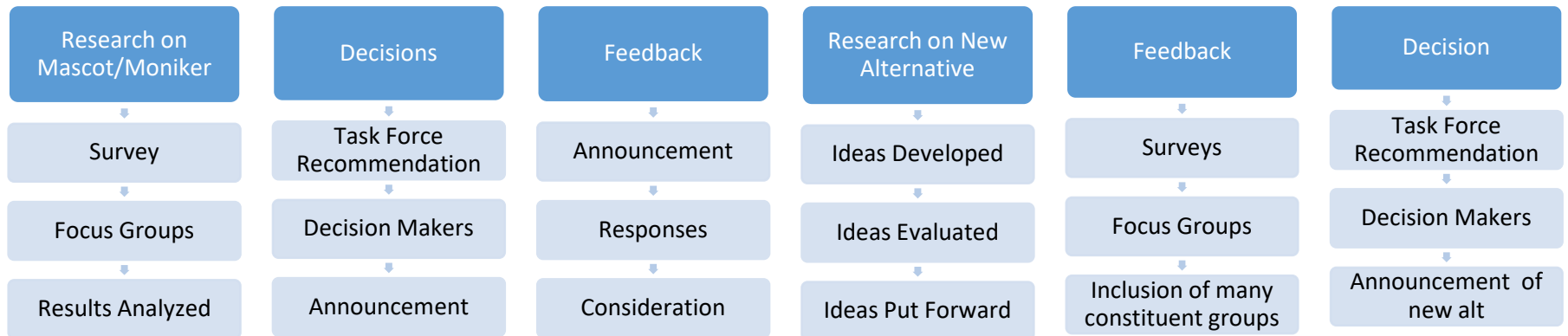
The task force will evaluate the strength of the two identities to determine if they appropriately represent the college for the next 75 years.

What do we need to know?

- Is the mascot, Joe Mountie, the right mascot to bring Mt. SAC into the future?
 - If not, what should be?
- Is the athletic moniker, Mounties, the right nickname for the college into the future?
 - If not, what should be?

What should Mt. SAC do? Let's make this work for us.

TASK FORCE DECISIONS:

- Survey first. Follow up with focus groups. Survey first is better to provide something to go off of in focus groups. We'll develop more steps later after we get results and analyze.
- Is decision to move away from mascot clear? Not exactly. Task Force has found issues with the mascot and is looking for outside feedback to better understand community perspectives.
- Survey will need to assess both mascot and moniker. We need to keep the survey neutral and not push people in a direction. Survey will reach out to faculty, staff, students, alumni, donors.
