For Faculty

Coming soon, The new Foothill Transit Line 295 from A(line) to C(ampus)!

Introducing Line 295! The new Foothill Transit line that runs every 20 minutes on weekdays, connecting our campus to areas including San Dimas, Azusa, Pasadena, Los Angeles, Long Beach, and more! We encourage you to take advantage of this free and eco-friendly alternative by using:

- <u>Class Pass:</u> Foothill Transit partners with select colleges and universities in the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys to offer unlimited rides at deeply discounted rates.
- GoPass: Eligible students can ride for free with the GoPass, thanks to a partnership between Foothill Transit and LA Metro. That's unlimited rides on Foothill Transit, Metro, and other participating agencies. Just register each semester and you're good to go—no fare required.
- <u>U-Pass:</u> This program offers students a reduced-fare transit pass good for unlimited rides across multiple transit agencies, including Foothill Transit and Metro.



Wild Wonder Micro Grant Program

<u>This Micro Grant Program</u> aims to support projects anywhere in the world. Eligible projects can include but are not limited to:

- Nature journaling events, trainings, classes, publications, etc.
- Launching a new nature journaling club or supporting one.
- Other projects or materials that help people engage with nature and nature journaling, increase the number of new nature journalers, and/or expand the capacity for people to teach others.
- Grant awards will range from \$250-\$1,000 USD.



Mt. SAC At The C3CONVERGE 2025



Sustainability Department Info Booths!


