Steve,

I would like to advise you and your editors that the sentence below, published in your article ("Foothill Transit customers react to changes, including new bus lines to Mt. SAC, Santa Anita Park"), contains an inaccuracy that you have continued to include in your articles about Mt. SAC

Foothill Transit already has five bus lines feeding into Mt. SAC, which enrolls as many as 60,000 students a semester and where parking is in short supply.

I must again remind you that Mt. SAC **DOES NOT enroll 60,000 students a semester**. We enrolled **59,343 over the COURSE OF ALL OF 2015-16.**

This number includes credit and non-credit students.

There is a great difference between an annual count and a term count. This distinction is very important to us. The perpetual use of this factual error is disappointing, and frankly, annoying.

It also is a disservice to your readers.

I have included a link to the California Community College Chancellor's Office DataMart, where you can find annual counts as well as semester counts for several years.
