

Mt. SAC cancels classes due to power failure, more than 880 SCE customers affected

WALNUT >> Classes were cancelled Monday night at Mt. San Antonio College due to a campus-wide power outage, school officials said on social media.

The campus lost electricity at 6:26 p.m., Southern California Edison Spokesman Jim Hanggi said. It was one of more than 880 customers affected.

Power was restored at 8:15 p.m., he added, except for a single customer as of 9:40 p.m.

“There was an underground cable error that caused the power outage,” Hanggi said.

The boundaries of the outage were south of East Valley Boulevard, west of Grand Avenue, north of Temple Avenue and east of La Puente Drive, he said.

Officials advised students to take care in exiting the campus.
