College grants for the affluent

Dozens of prominent colleges and universities routinely offer discounts and scholarships to students who have no demonstrated financial need. Some do it to lure top recruits. Others are seeking to ensure they have enough revenue.

This table shows full tuition, fees, room and board. It also shows: the share of new, full-time freshmen who are deemed to have no financial need and receive grants or scholarships from their schools; their average award in those cases; and the share of full-time freshmen who receive need-based grants or scholarships from their schools.

The no-need grants exclude athletic scholarships. The financial aid information is drawn from a Washington Post analysis of a survey colleges answered for certain publishers called the Common Data Set 2013-14. Some prominent schools, including Columbia University and the University of Chicago, declined to provide their full CDS survey data to The Post. Important caveat about public colleges: The listed tuition is for in-state students, but data shown here on financial aid combines awards for in-state and out-of-state students. The latter pay higher tuition.
