

## Mt. SAC Athletics Captures 2014-15 NATYCAA Cup Championship

June 8, 2015

(Sacramento, CA) The National Alliance of Two-Year College Athletic Administrators (NATYCAA) in association with the California Community College Athletics Association (CCCAA) named Mt. San Antonio College the 2014-2015 NATYCAA Cup Champions for the 3rd consecutive time and 5th time overall. The NATYCAA Cup recognizes overall athletic excellence at the two-year college level, based on post season finishes of a colleges top five men's and top five women's athletic teams.

With this years championship, the Mt. SAC Athletics Program shattered numerous records in the 12 year history of the award including:

- First college to win five NATYCAA Championships
- First college to win 3 consecutive NATYCAA Championships
- All-time point total of 187.5 points (previous record of 177.5 points, also held by Mt. SAC)
- Largest margin of victory by 26 points

Mt. SAC has had a strong presence in NATYCAA Cup History. The Mounties have never finished worse than sixth overall, placing fourth one time, second five times and first five times. The Mounties also own five of the top 10 scores of all-time, the highest adjusted point total of 187.50 (2014-15) and the highest non-adjusted point total of all-time (222 points in 2009-10 and 2010-11).
