

Women's Cross Country Team Captures 2014 CCCAA State Championship

(*Fresno, CA*) **The Mt. SAC Women's Cross Country Team ran away with the Women's Championship at the 2014 CCCAA State Championship**, scoring 78 points, on a perfect cool fall morning at the 3.0 mile Woodward Park Course in Fresno. Led by Freshman <u>Lindsey Keough</u> (6th place, 18:08) and Sophomore <u>Sierra Ungerman</u> (7th place, 18:22), the top 5 Mounties ran together throughout the race, finishing as a tight pack, with everyone in the top 35 and with a time under 19 minutes, 15 seconds. Second place was College of the Canyons who scored 104 points and Southern California Champion, Glendale College, took third with 109 points.

All of the Mountie Women ran under 20 minutes and finished in the top 50. Sophomore <u>Nichelle Jackson</u> also secured All-American Honors placing 12th with a time of 18:40. Freshman's <u>Xeomara Villalobos</u> (27th place, 19:07), <u>Melanie Deciga</u> (34th place, 19:15), <u>Dominique Delgado</u> (39th place, 19:18) and <u>Samantha Ogan</u> (44th place, 19:27) round out the Mounties 7-runner state championship team.

Head Coach Doug Todd captured his 4th women's cross country championship, exactly 20 years after he captured his very first CCCAA State Championship in the fall of 1995, with the women's cross country team. Todd, the most prolific coach in Mt. SAC Athletics History has now captured a total of 16 CCCAA State Championships, which is over a quarter of the 61 CCCAA State Championships captured by the total Mountie Athletics Program. He will have the opportunity to capture his 17th title in two decades when he begins the defense of his 2014 CCCAA Women's Track and Field Championship this coming spring.
