
2014 Class Pass Vote

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Mt. San Antonio Community College District require all students enrolled in one or more units of credit instruction, during either the spring or fall semesters, to pay a transportation fee? The fee would enable such students to receive a Class Pass which provides access to free bus transportation via Foothill Transit local lines and the Foothill Transit Silver Streak (Silver Streak runs between Montclair and Downtown Los Angeles) 7 days/week, 24 hours/day.

Students who enroll in credit classes for the fall semester will have access through the winter intersession. Students who enroll in credit classes for the spring semester will have access through the summer intersession. The fee per semester will be \$8 for part-time students (under 12 units) and \$9 for full-time students (12 units or more). The Transportation Fee will be a mandatory fee for all Mt. SAC students registered in the fall and spring semester.
