

2018 Educational & Facilities Master Plan

The College has kicked-off a collaborative effort to develop a new Educational and Facilities Master Plan (EFMP). The purpose of the EFMP is to determine how to best serve our students and community for the next decade and beyond.

Mt. SAC previously had separate Facility and Educational plans. This effort is an integrated process that will combine the two—the Educational Master Plan will inform the Facilities Master Plan and both will be provided in one comprehensive document

Why update the Master Plans?

California law requires that the governing board of a community college district establish a comprehensive master plan(s) for academic and long range facility needs. Mt. SAC's current Educational Master Plan was last updated in 2008-2009 and the Facilities Master Plans was approved in 2012 and a minor update was made regarding the farm area in 2014.

What is included in an Educational and Facilities Master Plan?

The educational component will include a linkage to the College's mission, vision, and values; background, history, and context section; a profile of the service district (12 cities served by Mt. SAC); analysis of individual programs (classes, degrees, continuing education, etc.) offered; and projections for enrollment potential, future growth, and space needs.

The facilities component will include existing and proposed building and infrastructure capacity of the campus to accommodate potential educational program and institutional support program expansion, as well as future demand and growth informed by the educational component.

Will the public be involved in the process?

Yes, a team of Mt. SAC employees and consultants will be conducting in person and on-line engagement throughout the EFMP process. A community advisory committee has also been assembled to provide feedback at various project junctures.
