- To create performance measurements, specifically for, but not limited to: response to emergencies and drills, failure frequencies, and communications to and from the campus community.
- 4. To identify external resources and protocols necessary for effective disaster response and recovery through Mutual Aid Agreements (MAA) and emergency partnerships.
- 5. To review and develop College Board Policies and Administrative Procedures related to campus emergency management.
- 6. To analyze budget needs and usage for maintaining College emergency preparedness.
- 7. To recommend improvements and changes related to College emergency preparedness to President's Cabinet.
- 8. To record minutes and make them available to the campus community.
- 9. To prepare annual or semi-annual State of Campus Emergency Preparedness report for campus community.
