

Follow Up on the Change from the TAP card to the Class Pass Sticker 3/03/2017

I just wanted to give you an update on this change from the TAP card to the Class Pass sticker. On Thursday 2/23 I met with Antonio Bangloy (Manager, Application Support and Development) and Chuong Tran (Sr. Systems Analyst/Programmer). Chuong did the programming in our system that registers the Class Pass for students. We determined that there are no programming or hardware changes needed to support a sticker attached to a student ID.

I also had a phone conversation with Katie Gagnon and confirmed that no additional programming changes would be needed. There would be a need to order new Photo ID cards for students with a revised layout on the back. Katie said that CI Solutions (our vendor) is willing to do this at no charge for our next purchase of Photo ID card stock.

I sent an email to Suzanne in the bookstore offering to coordinate a meeting to discuss the revised process for Fall 2017. I'm sure she will get back to me after the start of the semester rush dies down in the bookstore.
