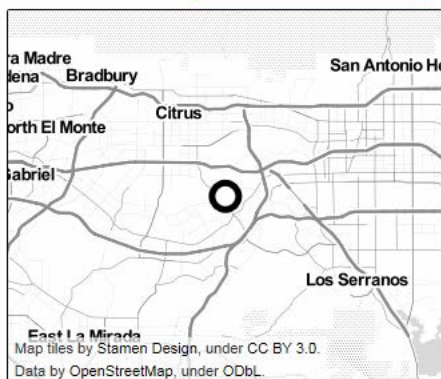

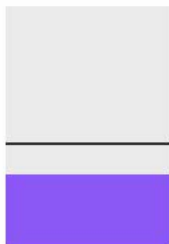

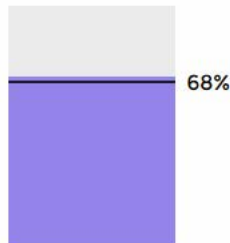
Depending on the federal, state, or institutional grant aid available, students in your income bracket may pay more or less than the overall average costs.

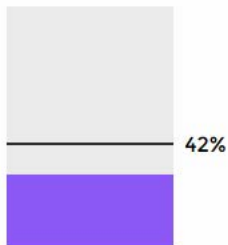

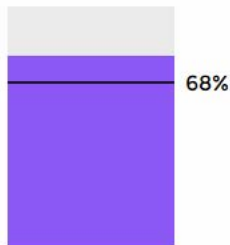

# Earnings After School

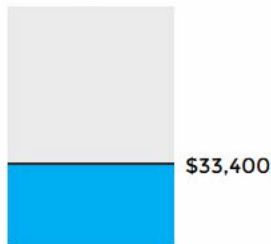


## Percentage Earning Above High School Grad

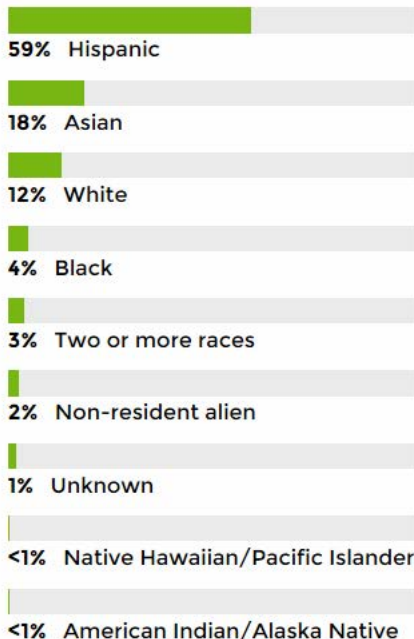
