

- 3. CTE Data Unlocked Technical Assistance for Strong Workforce Program Local Share Planning: Colleges that fulfilled CTE Data Unlocked training requirements are eligible for technical assistance. While most colleges identified a topic for the ten hours of support in their template for funding and technical assistance, colleges can elect to devote their support to data analysis and goal setting for the local share of Strong Workforce Program funds instead.
