

Summer Bridge Program & STEP  
Expansion Report

**Overview:** The Summer Bridge Program will expand to 410 students for the Summer 2017 term. In the last two years, Summer Bridge has served 368 students in 2015 and 324 students in 2016. To serve more students and maximize enrollment Summer Bridge in collaboration with the Summer Transition Enrichment Program (STEP) is planning to serve approximately 600 students.

Summer Bridge has the capacity to serve no more than 410 students due to its current structure (i.e. facilities, block scheduling, tutoring/supplemental instruction hours, fiscal sustainability, and program events/activities).

**Status:** The Summer Bridge Program application is open for submission we have received 50 applications thus far. We are working collaboratively with High School Outreach (HSO) who is actively recruiting students during high school visits. All applicants will be considered for either Summer Bridge or STEP. Summer Bridge on an annual basis receives over a thousand applications.
