Additionally, the aim of the Report Card is to educate and encourage college decision makers to adopt comprehensive smoke/tobacco-free policies that promote health and wellness for all members of their campus community.

## Smoke/Tobacco-Free Policy Rationale

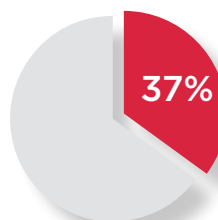
Why college and university policies go 100% smoke/tobacco-free:

- Decrease Exposure to New and Emerging Tobacco and Nicotine Products

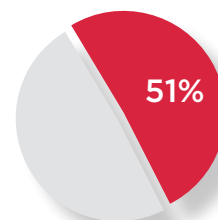

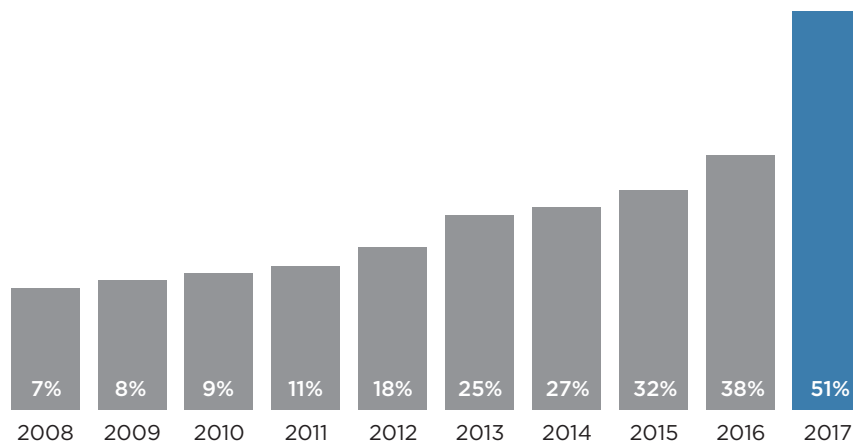
4-YEAR PUBLIC

(Community Colleges)



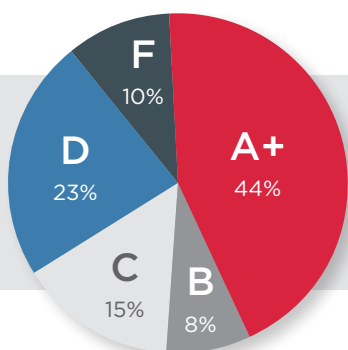
