

Chapter 7 – Human Resources

BP 7600 Campus Public Safety Officers

Reference:

Education Code Section 72330.5; **Penal Code Section 836.5**

The College shall employ campus public safety officers, who shall provide services as security guards or patrol persons on property owned or operated by the College. Their duties include, but are not limited to, protecting persons or property, preventing the theft of College property, and reporting any unlawful activity to the College and local law enforcement.

By virtue of this Board Policy public safety officers are designated as public officers and, thereby have the authority, protection, and responsibility specified in Penal Code Section 836.5.

The College President/CEO shall establish procedures necessary for administration of campus security. In addition, the College President/CEO shall enter into an agreement with local law enforcement, which includes that campus public safety officers shall cooperate with local law enforcement in performing their duties.

Every campus public safety officer who works more than 20 hours per week shall complete a course of training developed by the Bureau of Security and Investigative Services of the Department of Consumer Affairs as required by Education Code Section 72330.5(b).

Every campus public safety officer shall meet other requirements set out in Education Code Section 72330.5.
