

Through *FacultyEnlight*®, our online adoption platform, you can research and adopt course materials in one convenient location.

STEP 1:

Click the **Faculty Resources** on your bookstore website homepage. You will be automatically redirected to the *FacultyEnlight* website. You can also visit the *FacultyEnlight* homepage directly by going to www.facultyenlight.com.

STEP 2:

Already have an account? Just **Sign In**. If not, click **Create Account** to set one up in just a few, simple steps.

STEP 3:

To order materials, click Adopt.

Drop down menus make it easy to identify Campus, Term, Department, Course, and Section.

Want to use one textbook for all sections? Simply click **Select All**, and the textbook you choose will be added to each one.

STEP 4:

To choose materials, click **Continue**. Select **Search for Course Materials** to search by ISBN, Title, Author, or even Publisher.

From this screen, you can search your **History**, search your colleagues' adoptions, access your **Favorites Lists**, or order **Non-Text Materials**.

If your class does not require a textbook, just click the **No Materials Required For This Course** box.

STEP 5:

After you've found the right material, click **Adopt This Book**, then **Continue** to Review/Submit.

To select additional materials, click **Add More Materials**. From here, you will also mark course materials **Required** or **Recommended**.

When you've finished making all your selection, click **Submit Order**.

At Barnes & Noble College, our mission is to help students succeed — and ensuring that they have access to the most affordable course materials is core to that commitment. We work closely with thousands of publishers to maintain an industry-leading selection of affordable textbooks, allowing students and faculty to choose from flexibly priced rental, digital and used textbook offerings.

Our Price Match Program is just the latest example of our commitment to student success, ensuring that students get the best prices available on their course materials by providing price matching on textbooks advertised or offered from local brick-and-mortar bookstores or online retailers (i.e., Amazon or bn.com). The program does not include online marketplaces like "other sellers" on Amazon and BN.com Marketplace, or peer-to-peer pricing.

Under this program, price matching will be honored through the first week of classes, allowing students to shop online early and buy with confidence. If a student comes in after the first week of classes, we will gladly do a price match on that same day. Any price difference will be refunded to the customer via their original form of payment. The program includes purchase (used and new) and rental pricing, provided the rental term (number of days available) is comparable. This program gives students that extra peace of mind knowing they are getting the specific course materials their professors selected — at the lowest possible price.

The following conditions apply for the Price Match Program:

- The textbook must be in stock and available for immediate shipment at the local competitor or online retailer at the time of the price match request.
- Additional membership discounts and offers cannot be applied to the refund.
- The price advertised must be for the exact book, edition and format, including all accompanying materials, like workbooks and CDs, offered at the campus bookstore.
- The original receipt must be provided to show if the textbook was rented or purchased, along with the price.
- Digital titles and special orders are excluded.
- Price matching applies to same-condition items, used book to used book, new book to new book, used rental to used rental and new rental to new rental.

COMPLETE SOLUTIONS: REGISTRATION INTEGRATION









As part of our commitment to advanced technology, Barnes & Noble College provides a simple solution for students to order their textbooks – Registration Integration (RI). Registration Integration is designed to seamlessly transmit a student's course information from your school's online registration site to the campus bookstore's website, instantly generating a list of the books and supplies needed for each course. Our IT department works closely with your school to create the unique code needed to add to your school's registration system in order to make this connection.

Once RI is implemented, your school's online course registration system is linked to the bookstore's eCommerce textbook page. After a student registers for classes online, he/she can click on the textbooks link to view the

list of textbooks they'll need for next term's courses – assuring them that they are getting the right book for the right course. Students then select the books they want and the format they prefer (rental, digital, used, or new). Students can also choose whether to pick their books up at the campus bookstore or have them shipped to another location, all while using their preferred method(s) of payment.

For school's with multiple campuses, RI is simply configured to work with each unique eCommerce site. This delivers the optimum shopping experience for students, locking in textbook sales on campus.

Getting Started - A Quick Guide

- Access the course enrollment information from your registration office. If this is not already in place, contact your store or regional manager for assistance.
- Identify someone in your IT department to oversee the RI process.
- Send an email to Rl@bncollege.com with your school name, information about your IT contact, and (if available) the type of registration system used at your campus.
- Barnes & Noble College will respond to review the RI process and discuss specific system, programming and technical information.
- Your IT department can then begin the necessary programming,
 a process that typically takes approximately three to four weeks.
- When programming is complete, your IT department can test RI using the URL provided by Barnes & Noble College. Once testing is complete, you can launch RI on your campus.


