Notable Achievements/Accomplishments:

- Established dual enrollment agreements with 5 Unified School Districts
 - o Azusa Unified School District
 - I-Poly (LACOE)
 - o Pomona Unified School District
 - Rowland Unified School District
 - West Covina Unified School District
- Enrollment growth
- Other districts are seeking partnership agreements with Mt.SAC
- Hiring new staff to support Dual Enrollment program
 - o Director, Dual Enrollment
 - Administrative Assistant (47.5%)
 - SS Program Specialist I
 - o Administrative Specialist III
- Developed Dual Enrollment Mutual Agreement Committee (DEMAC)

Updates:

- Successfully enrolled students in all dual enrollment classes for fall 2017
- · School Districts assigned committed and dedicated liaisons to the dual enrollment effort
- Department Chairs have been extremely flexible, collaborative, and supportive of the dual enrollment efforts
- Reconvening meetings with existing partners for the development of academic year 2018-2019 dual enrollment offerings

Challenges:

- Need to establish a dual enrollment "registration training" for District liaisons
- Child Online Protection Act (COPA) has limited our ability to register students online at school sites

Moving Forward:

- Hiring personnel to help grow and expand dual enrollment program
- Continue to convene ongoing meetings with existing and prospective partners
- Establishing set timelines for the implementation of dual enrollment programs for academic year 2018-2019
