"For stations that only have one studio and four or fewer full-time employees, the FCC says it does not intend to limit the ability of the management-level personnel to leave the studio to conduct business so long as the management employee reports to the main studio. However, there still must be at least one person at the station during normal business hours." To move toward compliance, we would, at a minimum, extend the Lab Tech position from 10 to 12 months. We will continue to request a second PPT (19 hrs/wk/12 mo) position through the PIE process until this regulation is met. 2) In addition, Jason Shiff, our Radio Broadcasting Lab Tech has been an essential player in moving our radio stations from the analog to the digital world.
