Colleagues,

It is my pleasure to introduce Gregory Anderson, approved by the Board of Trustees last night as Interim Vice President of Instruction. Gregory has an Ed.D. in Higher Education Administration from USC, an MA in Teaching English as a Second Language from the School for International Training, and a BS in Speech Communication and English from the University of Wisconsin.

Dr. Anderson was President of Saddleback College for 2017-2018, Vice President of Instruction at Cañada College from 2013 to 2017, Dean of Learning Resources at De Anza College from 2011 to 2013, and a faculty member at De Anza College from 2005 to 2011 including being Director of the Student Success Center from 2005 to 2010 and Academic Senate President for 2011-12.

From 2001 to 20015 Gregory was a lecturer at USC and served in several director and coordinator positions. In 2000-02 he was Director of the English Language Program at Kwansei Gakuin University School of Policy Studies in Sanda, Japan also serving as Associate Lecturer of English at that university from 1997 to 2001.

As you would expect, Dr. Anderson is fluent in Japanese. In addition, he does quite well in Spanish, Sesotho and French and has basic understanding of Arabic and Setswana.***

I have served with Gregory in various system capacities over the last few years especially in the areas of technology and institutional research.

Please welcome Dr. Anderson to Mt. SAC. He began his service today and is contracted to serve through mid-November as the search for a permanent Vice President of Instruction is just beginning.
