Highlights

- 96% said the overall organization of the retreat was effective.
- 99% said they felt valued as a manager at Mt. SAC.
- 96% said they felt a sense of community among managers at the retreat.
- 96% agreed or strongly agreed that the coaching training was effective.
- 94% agreed or strongly agreed that they left the retreat with "a greater awareness of my role in contributing to a positive management culture at Mt. SAC."
- 94% agreed or strongly agreed that the leadership courage training helped them develop or strengthen skills that will apply to my role as a manager.
- 95% reported they were "satisfied" (50%) or "very satisfied" (45%) with the retreat.
- Several respondents cited the training exercises as particularly helpful.

Areas for Potential Improvement

- 30% thought sessions were "not the right length of time."
- Several respondents suggested more breaks.
- Several respondents suggested there be more interaction between tables.
- 17% disagreed that "the retreat was a safe place to share my perspective."
