2018-19 Budget - Ongoing Re: Mt. SAC:

- 2.71% COLA \$1.25M (one-time if hold harmless)
- Fulltime Faculty \$50M (10 positions)
- Student Equity & Achievement (BSSOT, SEQ, SSSP) Same \$\$ as 2017-18 for two years
- CA College Promise \$46M (\$1M ongoing)
- Adult Ed Data System \$5M (\$125K)

2018-19 Budget - One-time

- PT Adjunct Office Hours \$50 M
- Scheduled Maintenance, Instructional Equipment \$28.465M (for Mt. SAC \$600,000)
- Financial Aid Tech \$13.5M (about \$300K to Improve Pell/BOG/AB540)
- Growth \$6.3 M (included in Budget)
