
Shifting Migration

Close to 3 million Mexican immigrants who crossed into the U.S. between 1995 and 2000, according to the Pew Research Center. Between 2005 and 2010, that number fell to about 1.4 million, and between 2009 and 2014 it fell to about 870,000.

Migration from the U.S. to Mexico includes people born in Mexico, the U.S. and elsewhere; Mexico to U.S. includes Mexican-born people only.
