Mt. SAC Statway Progressions 2011, 2012, 2013, & 2014



Statway is a program at Mt. SAC that allows students who test below college level math an opportunity to move to college level math in two classes instead of three to five classes. The Statway program allows for guaranteed enrollment into the Statway college level class after the first Statway class has been passed. Classes are offered in the Fall (1st Statway class) and the Spring (2nd Statway class). The program began in the Fall of 2011 with Math 55 (1st Statway class) and Math 115 (2nd Statway class). In 2014 Statway courses changed to Math 70s (1st Statway class) and Math 110s (2nd Statway class).

The following is the progression of the Statway (SW) cohorts in comparison with matching course non-participants (NSW) of the respective terms. The progressions follow students from the fall they began Math 55 or Math 51 or Math 70s through summer 2015. All data for this report was generated from the Mt. SAC Banner Systems Data Warehouse.
