STEP

Summer Transition Enrichment Program (STEP) is a two-week summer experience designed for first year college students who want a head start. Students in STEP will complete their first college class for 1 unit (COUN 1 – Introduction to College) where they will learn strategies to be successful in college, and explore graduation, transfer and career options. Students will also take a campus tour, learn about campus resources and work one-on-one with a counselor to complete an educational plan. (909) 594-5611 • 9B, Second FI.

Aspire

Aspire provides educational support and services to increase the academic success, retention, degree completion, and transfer rates of current African-American and other college students enrolled at Mt. SAC. Students can participate in inspirational workshops, academic counseling and learning communities. The Aspire summer program allows students to enroll in a class where they receive academic counseling, earn college credit and meet African-American faculty, staff and students who can serve as a support community. ARISE

The Arise program provides support and a sense of community to current Asian American and Pacific Islander (API) and other college students enrolled at Mt. SAC. Students are given access to academic counseling, tutoring, free printing privileges and free laptop usage. Arise students can also participate in field-trips, leadership conferences, skill development workshops and cultural events. (909) 274-6622 • 16G

REACH

Reaching, Empowering, Achieving & Completing with Heart (REACH) is designed to support current and former foster youth students in their transition to college, at Mt. SAC and later as they transfer to a four-year university. The REACH program offers students access to priority registration, mentoring, housing resources, extended foster care resources (Assembly Bill 12), California Chafee Grant Program assistance, and more. Summer Bridge

Summer Bridge is a six-week program ideal for first generation first year college students who are seeking support throughout their first year of college. Participating students will learn skills to be successful in college and life, and build connections with campus staff, faculty, counselors, and peer mentors. Students will also take an introduction to college course and either a math or English class that will prepare them for college-level coursework and put them on a fast track to a college degree and transfer to a university. The Summer Bridge program offers students access to priority registration, counseling and advising, tutoring, free printing, computers and laptops, textbook loans, a study center, and more. DREAM Program

This program provides support services to first year and current DREAMers/Undocumented college students. It strives to provide a supportive environment that helps increase the personal growth and development of DREAMers through academic, career and personal counseling. Participating students receive assistance in applying for the California Dream Act/Financial Aid, scholarship opportunities, and referrals to DACA and/or medical services that are relative to this student population. Summer Pathways

Pathways is a program available to first year students and current Mt. SAC students interested in completing English and math courses quicker, with additional support. Pathways students will receive an in-class tutor or supplemental instructor, as well as a reserved seat in the next level course with the same instructor. These students become a part of a cohort, creating close bonds with their instructor and community of fellow students who take the same classes.

Summer Science Transfer Program

Summer Science Transfer is a six-week residential experience program at UC Santa Barbara designed to give current Mt. SAC students from various programs (ACES, ARISE, Aspire, DREAM, REACH) confidence in and knowledge of the transfer process to a four-year University. Students will complete one of two UC and CSU transferable science courses (GEOGRAPHY 1: Physical Geography lecture and lab or OCEANOGRAPHY 10: Oceanography lecture and lab). Participating students experience team-building exercises, leadership activities, transfer workshops, and learn about various university campus support programs. Mt. SAC staff will work with each student to increase their knowledge of the transfer process through workshops, student panels, and campus tours. (909) 274-4411• 9E, Third FL.
