

## Requirments of the Statute



- Placement in math and English must be based on high school performance: coursework, grades, and/or grade point average.
- Colleges must maximize the probability that a student will complete transfer-level English and math within a one-year (of taking the 1<sup>st</sup> course).
- A college shall not require remedial English or math coursework that lengthens time to complete a degree unless research shows that those students are highly unlikely to succeed in transfer-level coursework.
- When high school data is difficult to obtain or not available, a college may use self-reported data or guided placement, including self-placement.
- For student goals other than transfer a college must maximize probability of completing required college-level in English and math within one-year.
- Colleges shall use evidence-based multiple measures for placing students into ESL to maximize probability of completing transfer English in 3 years.
