

## Auto Award Summary Report Criteria

What I can tell you at this time is that A&R will evaluate the file over the next several days (prior to our meeting next week) and I'll have some findings to report. Upon initial inspection the largest population of 100% completers (TRANSF) students will be problematic for the reasons I outlined during our initial conversations. These 434 students are listed as 100% completers but keep in mind that the TRANSF is not a "real" degree of certificate that Mt. SAC actually can award. These TRANSF majors were created as a Counseling advising tool. What the 100% signifies is that these students have met 100% of the General Education requirements for the IGETC/CSU. This does not mean that they have met the Physical Education, Read Competency, Major Core or possibly even the GPA graduation requirements for an actual degree or certificate that we can award. The Evaluators will need to review each student's circumstances to determine what degree (if any) they might be eligible to receive. As you might suspect this will be a laborious process, especially if it is all manual. My strategy will be to try to pick the "low hanging fruit" first. That is to say that our first steps will be to evaluate the 44 non transfer degree/certs that appear to be complete. From there we will work on the 434 transfers and then work our way down to the from the 100% completers in descending order.

As I recall, the campus gets points for "transfer ready." Would these 100% completed TRANSF count as transfer ready in the funding formula? Are they currently already counted? If so, can we "double dip" and count them twice if they subsequently also receive a degree? How would we determine the answer to these questions?

Chuong cross checked the 4212 against Degree Works, and calculated how far they are from completing their declared goal. We found several students (not a lot) completed 100%.

- 2244 Students have a TRANSF Degree Code. 434 of those have completed 100%. (TRANSF is not a real degree, thus further investigation is required. We will need some guidance from Audrey and George.)
  - Some of the TRANSF Descriptions we found are:
    - Transfer – Business Admin, Accounting
    - Transfer – Finance
    - Transfer - Nursing
    - Transfer – Business
    - And Others
