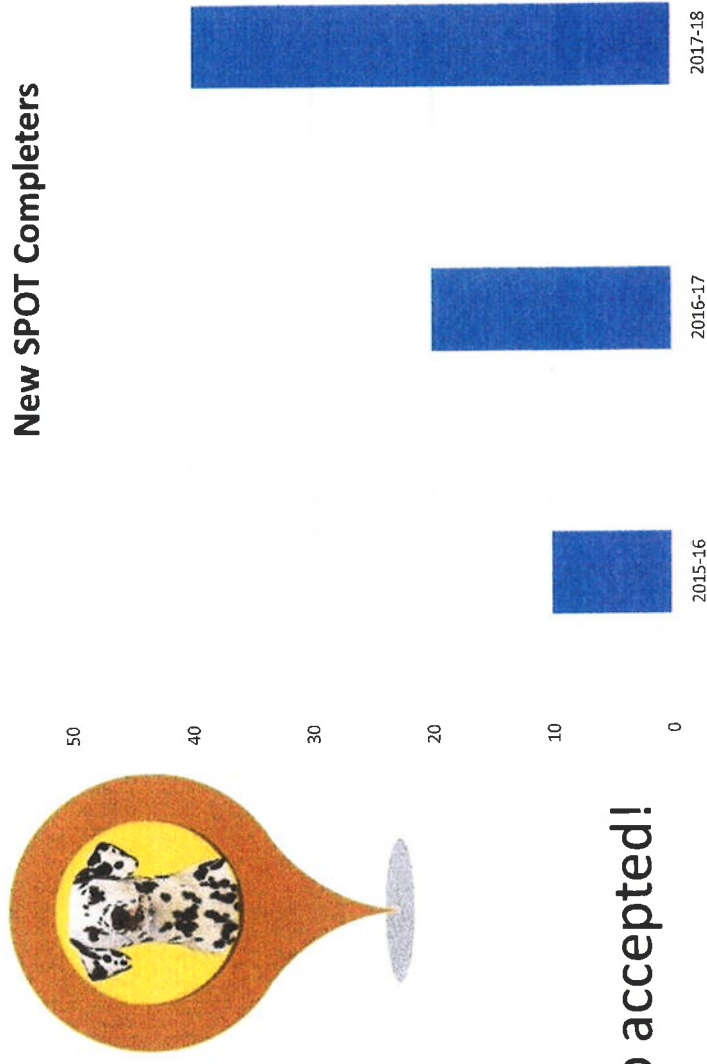

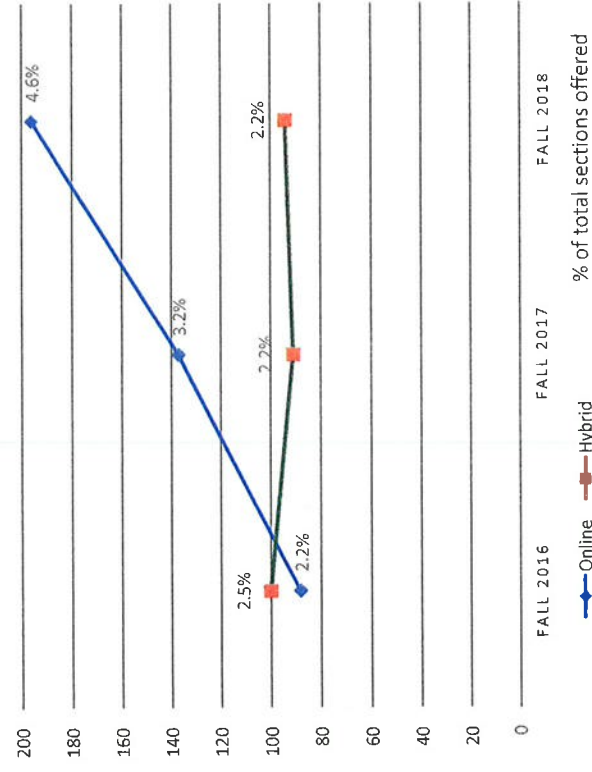

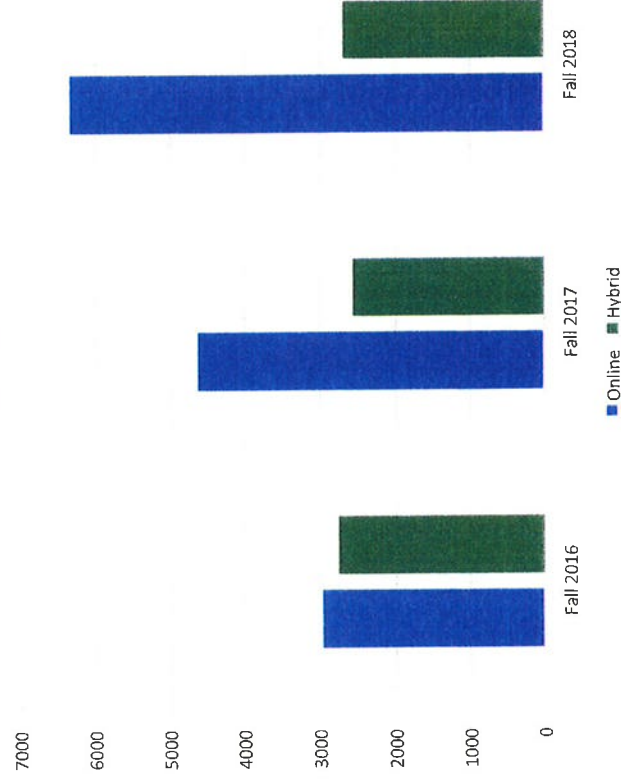


Increasing Distance Learning Sections & Students

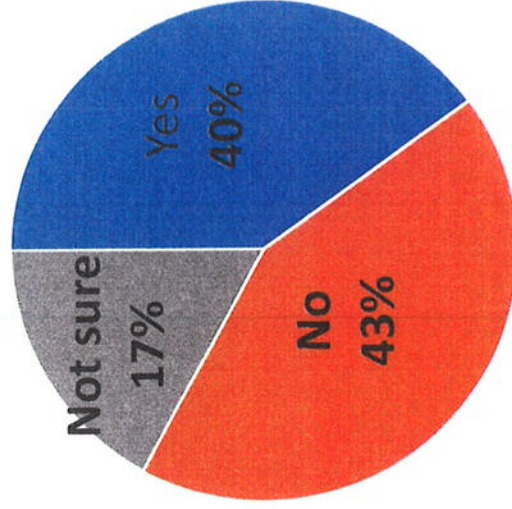


Number of Students Enrolled in
Online & Hybrid Classes



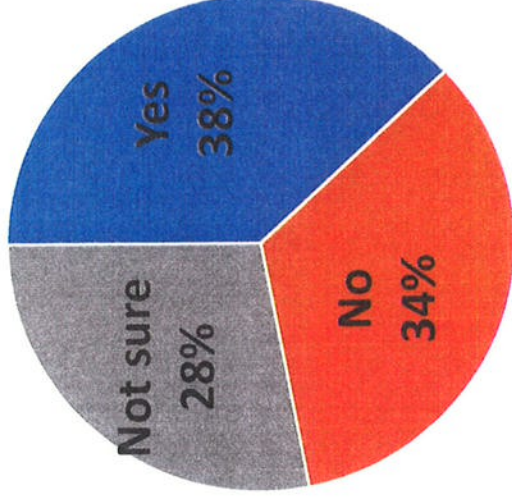
Student Interest in Online Degree/Certificate

Student Interest in *an Online Degree*



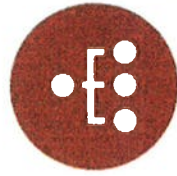

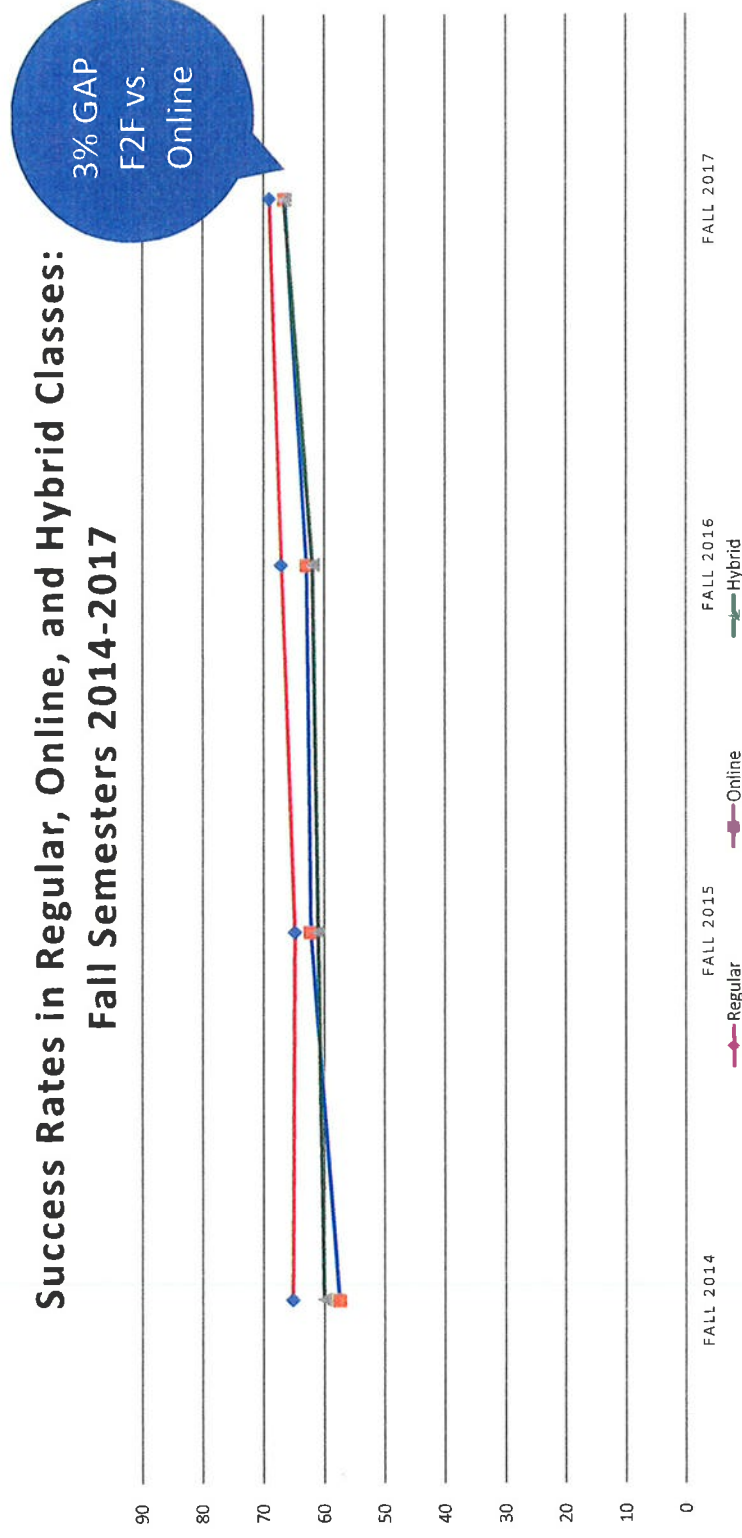

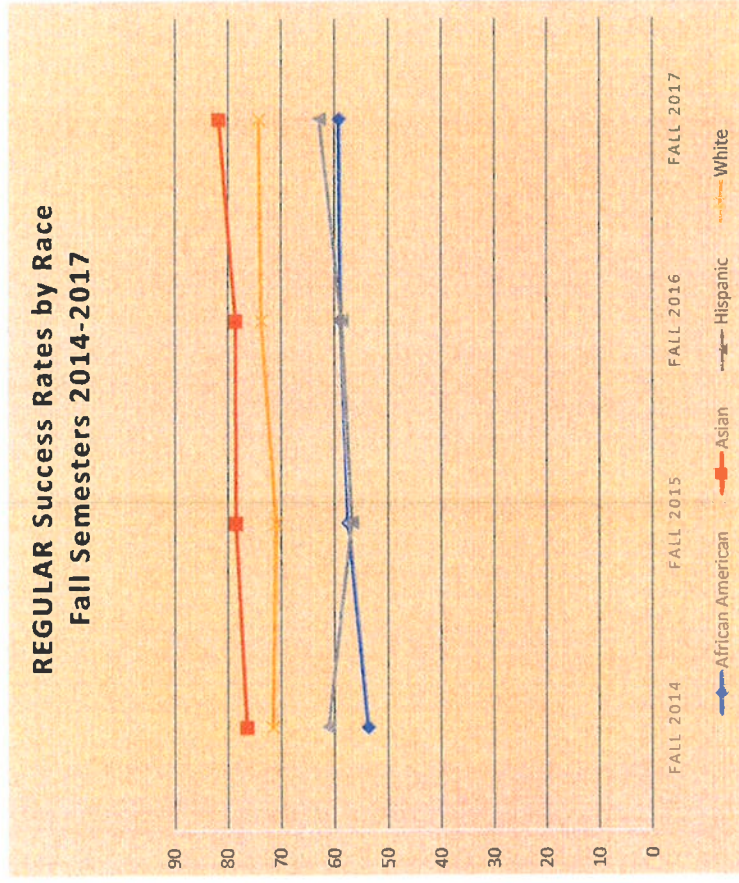
Overall Success Rates: Regular, Online, and Hybrid

Fall Semesters 2014-2017

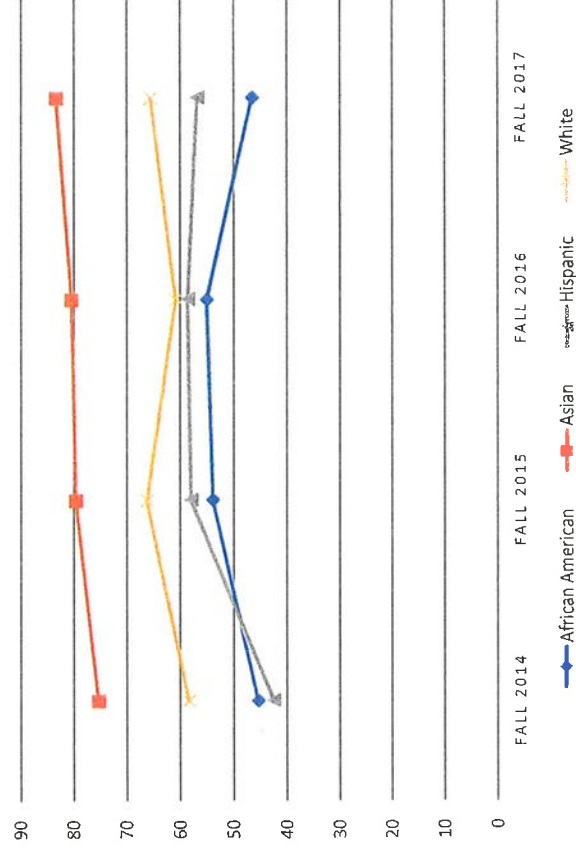


Regular & Online Success Rates by Race

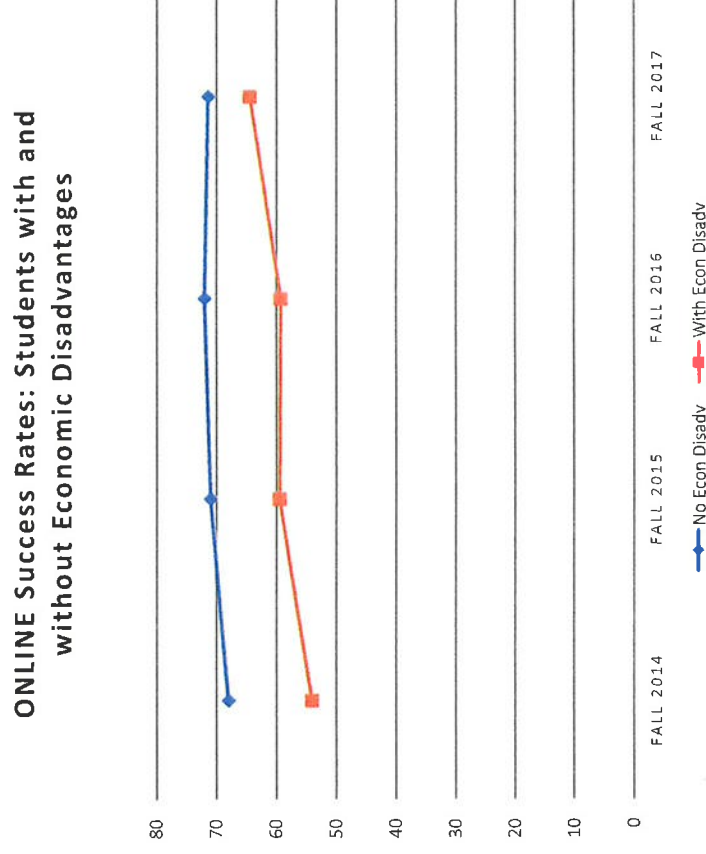
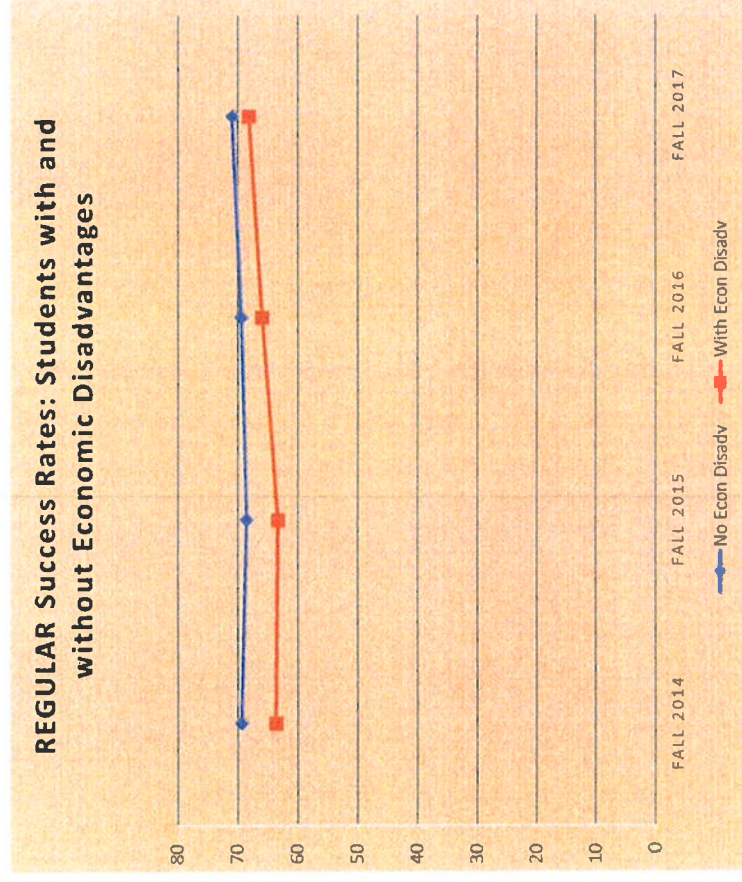
