Due to requests by several community colleges to be part of the statewide diversity law pathway program, the Cal-LAW board has voted today at its Annual Law Pathway Summit to reopen the application process.

If your college is interested, please contact Cal-LAW's Executive Director Leslie Cunningham at lcunningham@CALIFORNIALAWINC.COM. She will provide you with the application, and answer questions. Applications are due no later than June 3, 2019.

The current law pathway program has 22 high school law academies, 26 community colleges, 8 undergraduates, and 8 law schools in California through an MOU for special consideration at these partner law schools.
