- STREAMLINED DL AMENDMENT FORMS: 103 approved (53 4-year review; 50 new)
- REVAMPED SPOT COURSE IN CANVAS
  - SPOT registration: 134 faculty signed up
  - \* SPOT orientation: 12 faculty attended
  - \* Embed DL elements in WebCMS 10.0

F16 vs F17 = +3.6%

F13 vs F17 = +11%

# HYBRID

F16 vs F17 = +4.6%

F13 vs F17 = +4.8%

Online *Catching up* to F2F Success Rates!

- \* 10 years ago: 12% gap
- \* Fall 2016: 4% gap
- \* Fall 2017: 3% gap

Statewide success rate 2016-17: 62%

Mt. SAC: Fall 2016 62%

Fall 2017 **66% OEI helped!**


