# Marketing/promotion of Dual Enrollment in partnership with the high school

- 1) Student information sessions and classroom presentations on their campus
- 2) Parent and Student Orientation (evening)- English and Spanish
- 3) High school counselor referrals
- 4) School newsletter, website, and social media
- 5) E-mail communication with students and parents
- 6) Summer registration event to be held in July 2019
  - Students can register on our campus
  - Receive a campus tour (Library, Writing Center, Learning Lab, etc.)
  - Obtain their Mt. SAC Campus ID cards



#### **Dual Enrollment Student Process**

- 1. Apply to Mt. SAC (through Open CCC)
  - -Submit for the term they are planning to be a DE student

2. Assess

4. Register

- -Get their student ID# and username
- -Claim their account (Mt. SAC portal)
- 2. Assessment (if applicable)

**English** – AWE Assessment of Written English

**Math** - Students take the AQ

- 3. Complete and submit Dual Enrollment packet
  - With Student ID#
  - With all 3 signatures (student, parent, school)
- 4. Register for the course at their assigned date

 Curriculum course options are decided by Mt SAC and WCUSD. Finalized by Mt. SAC department chairs.








# **Early College Academy- Bassett USD**
