Guided Pathways to Success (GPS Advisory) Committee

(Operational Committee – Reports to Guided Pathways to Success Steering Committee)

Purpose

Guided Pathways is designed to transform how the College community identifies and responds to student needs for success. The Guided Pathways to Success Advisory Committee is responsible for making recommendations and leading implementation related to planning, assessment, policies, procedures, and activities leading students to clarify a path, enter a chosen pathway, stay on the path, and ensure they are learning.

Function

- 1. Engage college community in the development of pathways to help students complete their educational goals.
- 2. Improve student success by evaluating Guided Pathways research, locally and nationally, in order to create a consensus about core strengths and limitations and ways to leverage strengths and remove limitations.
- 3. Track Guided Pathways progress through metrics and benchmarks via the strategic plan and report out to campus.
- 4. Lead inclusive and systematic efforts in Guided Pathways implementation across campus constituents.
- 5. Evaluate the Mt. SAC Guided Pathways Work Plan and activities.
- 6. Review and make recommendations regarding the budget approval process for distribution of Guided Pathways funds.
- 7. Promote the Guided Pathways framework as an overarching structure for the College's planning and resource allocation process.
- 8. Identify existing student and faculty support structures, determine gaps in those support structures, and recommend action to close gaps.
- 9. Effectively communicate and embed Guided Pathways into the student experience.
