#### **Academic Technology**

- Contracted with Cireson to complete the implementation of the new Help Desk System.
- Deployed newly purchased Instructional Equipment in Humanities, Arts, and Technology and Health Divisions.
- Redeployed software in classrooms and labs to be current for the new spring term.
- Mt. SAC's Adobe software licensing is via the FCCC (Foundation for California Community Colleges). Adobe has announced sweeping licensing changes which require all community colleges to change how software is distributed effective November 2019.
   IT will test new deployment strategy during summer and roll out new Adobe software prior to the deadline.
- Working with Facilities on coordinating numerous construction projects that are in various phases of design, review, and build.
- Continuing to make progress with JAMF. This is the software that helps IT manage Apple devices, including iPads, iPhones, and desktop and laptop computers.
- Phase I to develop a replacement cycle plan for Instructional Equipment is almost complete. Equipment is now reporting-in to a central database including the age and type of equipment. Documentation includes an aging report for equipment.

#### **Security Update**

- Draft information security AP/BP proposal presented at ITAC for committee review.
- IBM SAN Volume Controller (SVC) migration completed mid-February.
  - Legacy SVC end of life on 3/31/2019.
- Backup project to replace tape library underway.
  - Backup storage appliance requirements identified; quote acquired from perspective vendor.
  - Inspecting Iron Mountain replication and restore capabilities with new proposal.
  - New version of IBM Spectrum Protect supports AWS and Azure cloud storage (will explore solutions).
  - Disaster Recovery documentation to be updated to reflect environment changes.
- IBM P-770 enterprise server reach end-of-life September 30, 2019.
  - o Planning for migration to IBM Power 922.
- Email protection appliance installed and configured. See following reports.
  - Spearphishing attacks using publicly available directory information from campus website is still ongoing.





#### **Applications Development & Support**

- The new Continuing Education Banner forms are moving to pre-production this month for testing by Continuing Education. These new forms will integrate data collection and eliminate some shadow systems.
- Additional information for student holds has been implemented in Banner self-service.
   Students can now see the detail behind a hold, what needs to be done to clear a hold, and contact information for the department that can assist with removing the hold.

- Completed MIS submission for fall 2018.
- Completed year-end processes for W-2, 1099, and 1098-T.
- Completed several critical upgrades of various Banner modules.
- Adding Reading Placement to the AQ and created a script to update AQ results of students who had previously taken the AQ with new Reading placements. A targeted portal announcement was sent to these students to inform them of their new Reading placements.
- Created an APEX application that enables students to apply to EOPS/CARE program online.

#### **Project Management**

- Phase I of the Questica budget application is scheduled to go live in March. Based on the feedback received by budget managers/administrators, Phase II will include modifications and additional functionality not released as part of Phase I.
- Purchasing requisition back-up documentation is live in OnBase! IT and Purchasing have partnered to implement an automated solution for the submission of requisition back-up in OnBase. The new process is currently being piloted by a small group in Administrative Services.
