# FairKids Field Trips

- Over 100,000 students experience the LA County Fair each year
- Year-round we have Field trips where students experience the Farm and agriculture
- Curriculum based on California State Standards



## CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

- Child Care offered during 1940's for Fair guests – year-round 1980.
- Partnered with University of La Verne 1991 – serving 100 students & Interns
- 250 children served each year
- Accredited by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC)





## Career and Technical Education

- Career education & training for high school students since 2008
- Partnership between Pomona and Bonita Unified School Districts
- Currently serving 250 students annually in 5 pathways
- Career exploration & essential skills



# Agriculture in the Farm

- Courses offered in Urban Farming
- Students learn agriculture, farm management & sustainability
- Have an articulation agreement with Mt. San Antonio College Agriculture program

ACTEC courses include

## o 3-D Art/Ceramics

- o Learn design skills
- o Pricing/marketing
- o Design career exploration



## o Fashion Design

- o Skills of garment design
- o Exploration of style and branding
- o Marketing & pricing



## Alex Xydias Center for the Automotive Arts

### Automotive Arts program

- 2-year course pathway
- Serving 40 students per year



### Welding to begin Fall 2019

- 2-year course offerings
- Teaching all facets of welding for adults in Fall and high school students in 2019





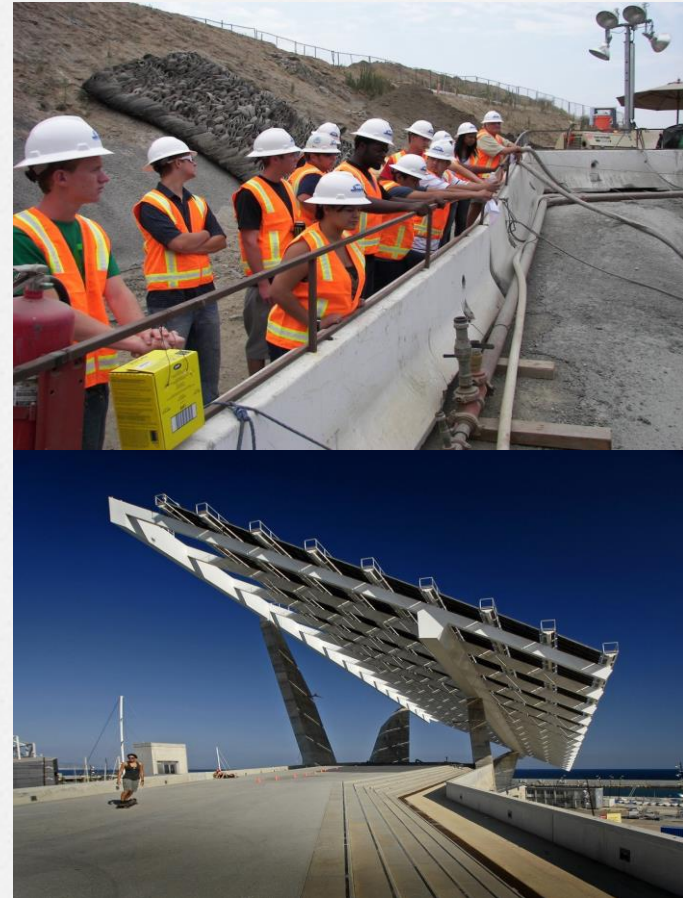
# Culinary & Hospitality
