- Members may use non-corded hand tools after joining.
- Makerspace Employees will provide training on 3D printer, vinyl cutter, heat transfer machine & laser cutter.
- Safety Certification is required for use of corded tools, and to use large-scale machinery.
- We can recommend classes to learn how to use machines.

The Mountie Makerspace is open to everyone. Mt. SAC students may use the Mountie Makerspace as a benefit of their normal Mt. SAC fees and tuition. Mt. SAC faculty and staff may also sign up for free. Community members first sign up through Community Education before becoming a Mountie Makerspace member.



Member Use of Mountie Makerspace:

1. Everyone must become a Makerspace member before creating or watching creation of items in the Space, safety requirements apply to everyone
2. Each member is responsible for making their own items
3. Most materials must be provided by members. There are a limited amount of free supplies, once gone there probably won't be more
4. The reservation system can be accessed at mountiemakers.com/reservation, username is your Mt SAC ID# ("A#") or community ed#, default password is "password"
5. Please respect the space and other people in it: keep it clean, be safe, be considerate. If you don't know how to do something, ask before trying
6. There are currently no limits on the number or types of items that can be created. Several machines have time limits of 4 hours of use per day.
