Participate in CVC Finish Faster Online

Enroll More Summer CSU Students Online April 4, 2019

Finish Faster Online, an important component of the CVC Exchange, allows students to easily search for online, transferable courses across California Community Colleges. This is a service of the California Virtual Campus-Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI), funded by the Chancellor's Office.

This summer, the CVC-OEI is again partnering with Cal State Online on a joint project that will provide students with the ability to easily search for thousands of online courses offered by both CCC and CSU Campuses. This intersegmental collaboration provides students with incredible access across the scale and of both systems, and will be promoted by both CVC-OEI and Cal State Online.

For this summer partnership, CVC-OEI is <u>inviting every California Community College to participate</u> by having their online class sections listed in the Finish Faster Online course finder at <u>cvc.edu</u>. Already this year, more than 68,000 students have used the Finish Faster Online course finder at the <u>cvc.edu</u> website, and more than 2,000 have completed an application to at least one California Community College as a result.

If your college would like to participate, we will need access to your public schedule data in a CSV format in order to accurately display course and section information. This is a fairly routine type of task for your IT staff. Our team has created instructions which can be found at https://cvc.edu/course-finder-csv-instructions/ and we can also provide additional technical information as needed. We are already receiving this data, either by CSV file or web accessible URL, from 43 colleges.

We will begin displaying summer classes (where available) within the next few weeks. Please take advantage of this opportunity to reach more students if you are not already participating!
