

Work Groups: CB21 and MIS Revisions for AB 705 and Funding Formula Implementation, 8/1/18



Summary

In order to accurately track whether students complete transfer-level English and math in a year, for the purpose of evaluating AB 705 implementation and the funding formula, more accurate information is needed. First, additional MIS flags are needed to identify courses that qualify as transfer-level English and math that are not in an English or math TOP code. Second, the CB 21 elements need to be revised to reflect the transition from a model with a sequence of pre-collegiate courses to a model where most students will be placed into transfer-level courses with appropriate supports. Third, information is needed to track these supports, such as how to identify co-requisite courses. Finally, greater attention needs to be paid to how ESL students are flagged in MIS, to more accurately track progress toward English language proficiency goals outlined in AB705. This work needs to be coordinated with crosswalk efforts already underway between CB 21 and the federal Educational Functioning Levels as part of AEBG.

Process

A set of work groups will be convened that are comprised of ASCCC-appointed noncredit and credit math, English, and ESL faculty; RP Group-appointed researchers; Academic Affairs staff; WEDD staff; and DII staff. WestEd will provide coordination and facilitation support to this group.
