







Five-Stage Reopening Process Based On Risk

Stage One

Previous

Safer at Home Order Planning for Recovery Stage Two

Now

May 8th

 Florists, some retailers, car dealerships, golf courses and trails

Soon

- Other low-risk businesses (manufacturers, offices, retail)
- Essential health care
- Outdoor recreation and libraries
- Museums, cultural centers, galleries

Stage Three

TBD

- Higher-risk businesses (body art, massage, bars/ nightclubs)
- Movie theatres and bowling alleys
- K-12 Schools
- Colleges and universities



Stage Four

TBD

- Highest risk businesses (entertainment venues)
- Large conventions
- Sporting and spectator events
