2019-20 Faculty Candidate / Recruitment Process Analysis

Background:

- 1. There were a total of 1,975 applicants for the 45 faculty positions. 1,418 applicants who submitted their applications prior to the initial screening date met the minimum qualifications (MQs) and were reviewed by a hiring committee.
 - a. 282 of the 1,975 applicants, applied after the initial screening deadline
 - b. 56 of the of the 1,975 applicants withdrew from the recruitment process
- 2. Of the 1,418 applicants that met MQs, 47% were male, 52% were female, 0.6% were non-binary, 0.4% did not disclose their gender.
 - a. Of the 250 applicants that were selected for an interview, 44% were male, 53% were female, 0.4% were non-binary, 2.4% did not disclose their gender.
- 3. Of the 1,418 applicants that met MQs, 44% were 40 years or older, 45% were under 40 years, and 11% did not disclose their age.
 - a. Of the 250 applicants that were selected for an interview, 48% were 40 years or older, 43% were under 40 years, and 9% did not disclose their age.
- 4. Of the 1,418 applicants that met MQs, 2% identify as Alaskan Native/American Indian, 14% identify as Asian/Pacific Islander, 8% identify as African American, 30% identify as Hispanic/Latino, 3% identify as Middle Eastern/N. African, 1% identify as multiple ethnicities, 31% identify as White, and 12% did not disclose their race/ethnicity.
 - a. Of the 250 applicants that were selected for an interview, 1% identify as Alaskan Native/American Indian, 11% identify as Asian/Pacific Islander, 4% identify as African American, 34% identify as Hispanic/Latino, 4% identify as Middle Eastern/N. African, 4% identify as multiple ethnicities, 32% identify as White, and 9% did not disclose their race/ethnicity.

Summary:

- 1. Of the 45 applicants hired, 26 are female, zero identify as non-binary.
- 2. Of the 45 applicants hired, 17 are 40 years or older.
- 3. Overall of the 45 applicants hired, 10 are Hispanic, 7 are Asian/Pacific Islander, and 11 did not disclose their race/ethnicity.

Issues/Concerns:

- 1. Of the 1,418 applicants who met MQs 2% were Native American and 8% were African American.
- 2. No Native Americans or African Americans were hired.

3. Protected groups are being screened out by hiring. Of the 250 applicants who were selected for an interview, 1% were Native American, and 4% were African American.

Action Plan:

- 1. Increase advertising with publications geared towards Native Americans and African Americans to assist in diversifying the applicant pool.
- 2. Increase job fairs/conferences that reach out to underrepresented protected groups.
- 3. Review initial screening timeline and choose dates that allow applicants to apply after proper advertising through publications and job fairs/conferences.
- 4. Continue to fully cover travel for applicants who travel more than 150 miles each way for all phases of the recruitment interview process.
- 5. Work with the Equity Minded Workgroup to directly train hiring committees for faculty recruitments.
- 6. Find additional trainers and resources for faculty recruitment hiring committees.

Resources:

1. \$100,000 one-time funding request from the Equity Minded Workgroup to continue the equity minded hiring process and training (funding will be used to support the actions).
