Word Format: The Word format was created in response to a request from the field for planning and development. All Collaborative College Partners will complete their Word format templates and submit to Lead Proposers on or before Friday, March 20, 2020 to allow the leads time to compile and synthesize their master proposal drafts in time to submit to college Presidents or District CEOs on Friday, April 3, 2020 for review and signature. Collaborative College Partners will also need to submit their drafts to their Presidents or CEOs for review and signature. Final proposals must be submitted via Google Online Platform on or before Friday, May 22, 2020 by 5:00pm.

Note: Please note that between Friday, April 3, 2020 and Friday, May 22, 2020, Lead Proposers and Collaborative College Partners can work with their respective Presidents and CEOs to make required or necessary adjustments to draft proposals. Lead Proposers are required to compile all Collaborative College Partner's forms into one (1) PDF document for uploading to the Google Online Platform. The Lead Proposers' master budget detail must also be uploaded to the Google Online Platform.
