Dual Enrollment Counselor Budget Information

In 2019-2020 our Counseling department funded 4 part-time Dual Enrollment (DE) Counselors. We have been informed recently that the Counseling budget has been decreased and they can only provide DE with 1 part-time Counselor.

The Dual Enrollment program is proposing a budget allocation to support ongoing funding of 3 DE Counselors. The Counselors will continue to provide ongoing advisement, guidance, early alert, and support to our DE students for 2020-2021.

Program Information

In 2019-2020, the 4 part-time DE Counselors worked with and provided support to over 2,000 dual enrollment students in 88 course sections at our 25 partner high schools.

It is projected that for 2020-2021, the DE Counselors would provide support to over 2,800 dual enrollment students in 142 course sections at 31 partner high schools.

The DE counselor roles include:

- Guidance and support for dual enrollment students directly at the high school sites.
- Responding to student e-mails, phone calls, and conducting Zoom/Cranium Café meetings with students.
- Communication with DE faculty to assist with students who are struggling in the course.
- Intervention with students who are having academic challenges in the dual enrollment course.
- Referrals to the Mt SAC financial aid department and behavior and wellness team.
- Registration assistance and follow up.

- Communication with high school lead Counselors regarding marketing and promotion of dual enrollment courses. Presentations in classrooms.
- Facilitating workshops such as academic success, time management study skills, and career planning.
- Providing information for students who plan to attend Mt SAC, which includes Summer Bridge, STEP, summer and Fall registration details.
- Creating educational plans for students planning to attend Mt SAC.
