



COVID-19 BEST PRACTICES

Prevent the Spread - Paramedic Academy Plan

Our plan for Mt San Antonio College to accommodate the social distancing for our Paramedic Academy:

Plan:

1. The class will be held at our Lab Classrooms on campus in building 28B room 201 and room 209. We will control all access to the lab classrooms.
2. All cognitive instruction will take place online. Faculty will place Power Points and cognitive lessons on-line in addition to conducting synchronous lessons utilizing Zoom or other online platforms.
3. All psychomotor instruction be conducted by splitting the classes in groups of 4 or less including one instructor. We will have no more than (2) groups of students come to campus at any one time utilizing one lab for a group of (4) students at a time.
4. Student and Staff movement in the building will be controlled via pedestrian traffic patterns keeping everyone moving in the same direction to enter and exit the building.
5. In-coming students will line up on the South/East corner of building 28B in front of the exterior stairs adjacent to parking lot D in a single file line maintaining 10-FOOT CLEARANCE BETWEEN EACH STUDENT waiting to be screened one at a time by the instructors. Students will NOT enter any building or facility until screened and cleared.
6. Log on to the Mt San Antonio COVID-19 Health Screening Log Smart Sheet and complete the "COVID-19 Student & Staff Health Questionnaire"
7. Temperature check with SEEK devise/no-touch thermometer. Retest if over 37.5°C
8. If a student is found to be symptomatic or have been exposed to anyone who has been symptomatic, they will be sent home. The student will not be allowed to return until they have been fever free for 48 hours and have a Doctors clearance to return.
9. Once all students & employees have been checked and cleared, they can enter the building.
10. If any positive results, notify the Assistant Director of Public Safety Programs immediately and do not allow that student or employee enter the training building.



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11. One all students have been screened they will be placed in one of two labs where there are currently (5) tables. We will have one student at each table and one table for the instructor.
12. The instructors will demonstrate to the student the skill that is being taught, and each student one by one can demonstrate the skill and conduct reps.
13. The students and instructors will disinfect all surfaces and equipment used prior to leaving each lab.
14. After two hours, the two groups will switch places and learn the skills being taught in the other room.
15. The students will ALL wear masks while on campus, wipe down table and chairs, and wash hands frequently.
16. Students will continually be briefed and updated on COVID19 medical information as the CDC gives updates.
17. Students will be required to wear a cloth face covering/mask while on campus.
